1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned A.G.A. for the State-respondents and perused the material on record.
2. The writ petition has been filed praying for quashing the F.I.R. dated 24.02.2024 giving rise to **Case Crime No. 128 of 2024, under Sections 188, 447, 353, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 34 of I.P.C., Police Station- Bisarakh, District- Gautam Buddha Nagar,**
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that initially the petitioner was not named in the F.I.R. nor charge-sheeted therein. Thereafter, further investigation was directed wherein the petitioner has been implicated on false allegations.
4. Learned AGA has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. Under the totality of facts and circumstances of this case and for the reasons given in the order dated 10.7.2024 passed in **Criminal Misc. Writ petition No. 7463/2024 (Shobhit Nehra Vs. State of U.P.)**, this writ petition is **disposed of** directing that till cognizance is taken by court on police report submitted under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C./193(3) B.N.S.S. the respondents are restrained from arresting the petitioner pursuant to the impugned First Information Report, subject to cooperation in ongoing investigation.
